<u>Advent is a time of preparation for the celebration of the birth of Jesus Christ and to</u> welcome him once again into our hearts and lives. Some symbols and signs associated with advent are : The advent wreath, the Jesse tree and the colour purple .The Advent wreath has candles standing upright, representing the four Sundays of Advent. The round ring of the Advent Wreath represents eternity-time without end. As the circle is never ending, so time with God goes on and on. The evergreens are for eternal life, life without

end. Evergreens do not die in the winter and like them God is always fresh and new. The candles remind us of Christ 'Light of the World'.

1st CANDLE – (purple) THE PROPHECY CANDLE or CANDLE OF HOPE



This candle is called the "Hope" or "Prophet's Candle," symbolising the anticipation of the coming Messiah and the hope that He brings to the world.
