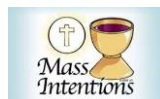

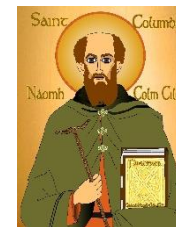

St Colmcille-Abbot and Missionary - Feast Day 9th

June

Columba was born on 7th December 521 in Gartan, Co Donegal, a descendant of the Irish High King Niall of the Nine Hostages. He was one of twelve students of St Finnian and became known as the Twelve Apostles of Ireland. He became a monk and eventually ordained a priest. Leaving Clonard Abbey where he trained, he went to found his first monastery in Derry. He went on to found more monasteries and churches all over Ireland including in Durrow and Kells. Upsetting his teacher St Finnian by copying a manuscript this compelled him to leave Ireland as an act of penance around 563. With twelve companions he settled in Iona in Scotland where they set up a monastery. He travelled and preached the gospel in Scotland and created a centre for literacy in the region. He died on 9th June 597
